LESSON 5 -- God’s Creation - The Dry Land (Soil)

TEACHERS: Pray together and read Genesis 1:9-13

OPENING TIME: Sing songs from Toddlers Songbook

“And God saw it was good. And God saw it was good. He made the earth for you and me. And God saw it was good. (Tune: “Let Us Exhibit Christ”)

BIBLE VERSE: “And God called the dry land Earth...and God saw that it was good.”
Gen. 1:10

LESSON:

1. God loves man, so in His creation God prepared everything in the heavens and on the earth so man could have a very pleasant place to live.
2. On the third day God brought forth the dry land. Teachers can use the flannel board or the blow-up globe ball to illustrate.
3. Do you remember the three kinds of dry land that we saw last week? (sand, rocks and soil) Can you tell us where on the earth you can find sand? (beach, desert) Where do you find rocks? (on the earth, in the earth and even in the sea.) Where do you find soil or dirt? (on farms, in your yard)
4. God was happy when He saw the Earth appear because He had a plan. God wanted many things to grow on the earth. He was busy getting everything ready. (This is what your mother does when she gets out all the ingredients before she makes a cake.)
5. Today, we will prepare the soil to plant some seeds.
