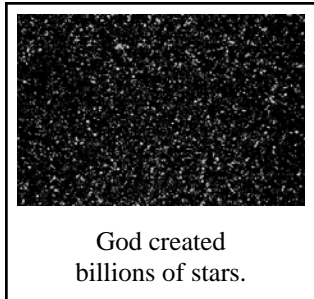


God Also Creates the Stars

The Fourth Day of Creation

God created the sun, He created the brightest object in the whole sky. The sun is so bright that we cannot really look at it; we have to look away.



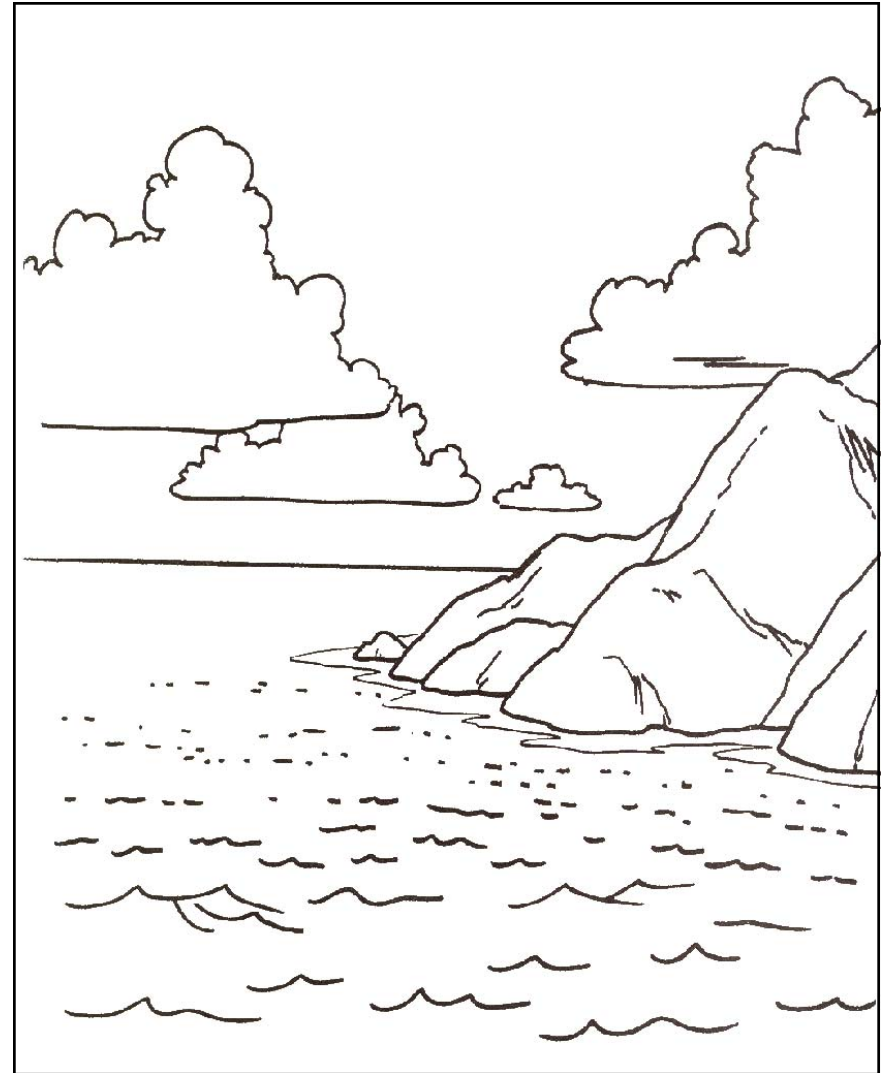
