LESSON 28 WINTER -- ICE & SNOW

TEACHERS: read and pray: Ex 16:14-15

OPENING TIME: Sing Songs for Toddlers

BIBLE VERSE: Psa 74:17b-“You (God) formed the summer and the winter.”

LESSON

1. Earth’s yearly trips around the sun form the seasons.
2. Winter brings cold temperatures. Does your family have a thermometer to tell you how cold the temperature is outside? Some cars have a display that tells us.
3. Show children a picture of one or bring one. Put the thermometer in a pan of ice to show them how the temperature falls.
4. Ice is a form of water. Cold rain can freeze upon hitting the ground or other cold surfaces. This makes ice.
5. There is snow on some cold days. How does the sky look when it is snowing? Are you able to see the sun? What color do you see in the sky?
6. You step outside. It is snowing; the ground is covered with snow. What do you hear? Loud noise or softer noise? (The earth may have a “hushed sound”) If it is very cold your feet may make a crunchy sound as you walk.
7. The snow falls on your face. How does it feel? Cold? Warm? Heavy? Light? Tickly?
8. Have you tried to walk on ice? Could you run? What kind of shoes do you wear?
9. In Oklahoma, only walk on ice in puddles or ice at the skating rink. Ice on ponds or lakes is not safe. The ice is too thin.
10. In the winter God sends the snow. The Bible says “ To everything there is a season”
