LESSON 50 FIREFLIES AND DRAGONFLIES

TEACHERS: Pray together, read Genesis 1:10 – 13

OPENING TIME: SONGS -- Why was a Cup Made

BIBLE VERSE: Gen 1:26 “... over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.”

LESSON:

1. Fireflies are commonly known as lightning bugs.
2. Fireflies live in fields, meadows, forests, and other natural habitats.
3. They are easily seen in the summer nights.
4. Fireflies contain specialized **cells** in their body, which glows when mixed with oxygen in the air.
5. Dragonflies just might be the most charming among the flying insects.
6. They don’t sting or bite. They don’t carry diseases or germs.
7. And they have bright colors and an amazing way of flying.
8. Dragonflies have sharp teeth. They are fierce hunters. Some dragonflies float over the water like hawks looking for prey. Others dart about grabbing prey quickly.
9. Dragonflies catch insects with their feet. They are expert hunters.
10. A dragonfly can eat hundreds of mosquitoes in a day.

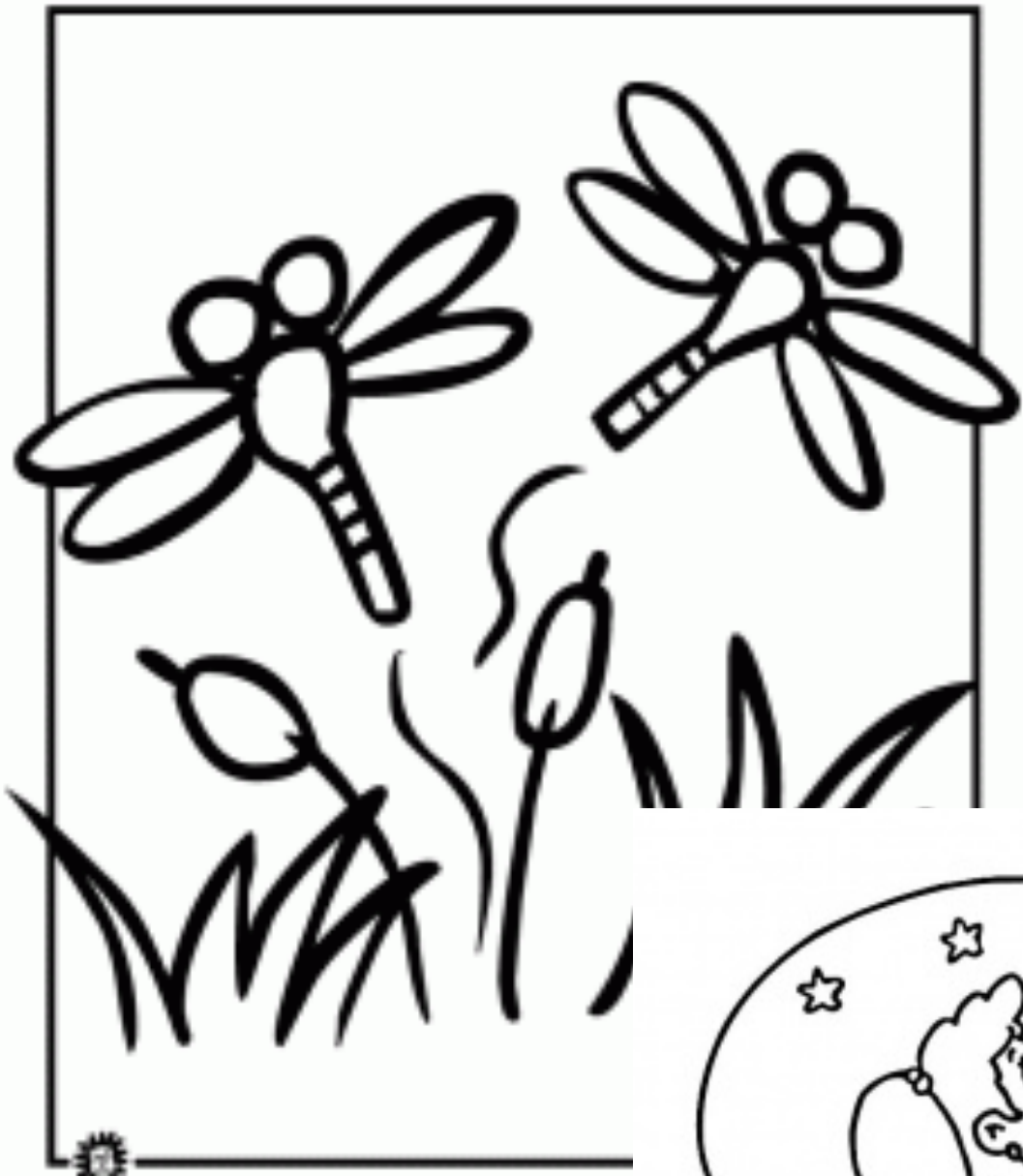
