LESSON 16 SEA LIFE – SEALS AND WALRUSES

Teachers: pray and read Genesis 1:20-23

Opening Time: Songs from Toddler Song Book or others

Bible Verse: “And God created the great sea creatures.” Gen. 1:21

Lesson:

1. On the **fifth** day, God brought forth moving creatures in the waters.
2. What big sea creature did we talk about last week? Whales. They are the biggest ones but there are many more very interesting creatures.
3. Today we want to study seals and walruses. These creatures have something different than whales. They have fur.
4. Old grandpa seals also grow long whiskers (like cats). Their favorite meal is fish, which they catch during the night.
5. Seals like to swim and play in the oceans, but they also like to stretch out on the warm rocks on the shore. They “flip” their flippers and make lots of noise talking to each other.
6. When seals are sleeping in the ocean waters they hold their flippers up above the water toward the sun. This helps heat the rest of their body when the water is cold.
7. Unlike the seals, walruses have tusks and whiskers. The tusk and stiff whiskers are the main features that differentiate a walrus from a sea lion. Walruses are also bigger than sea lions.
8. Baby seals are called pups, baby walrus are called calves.

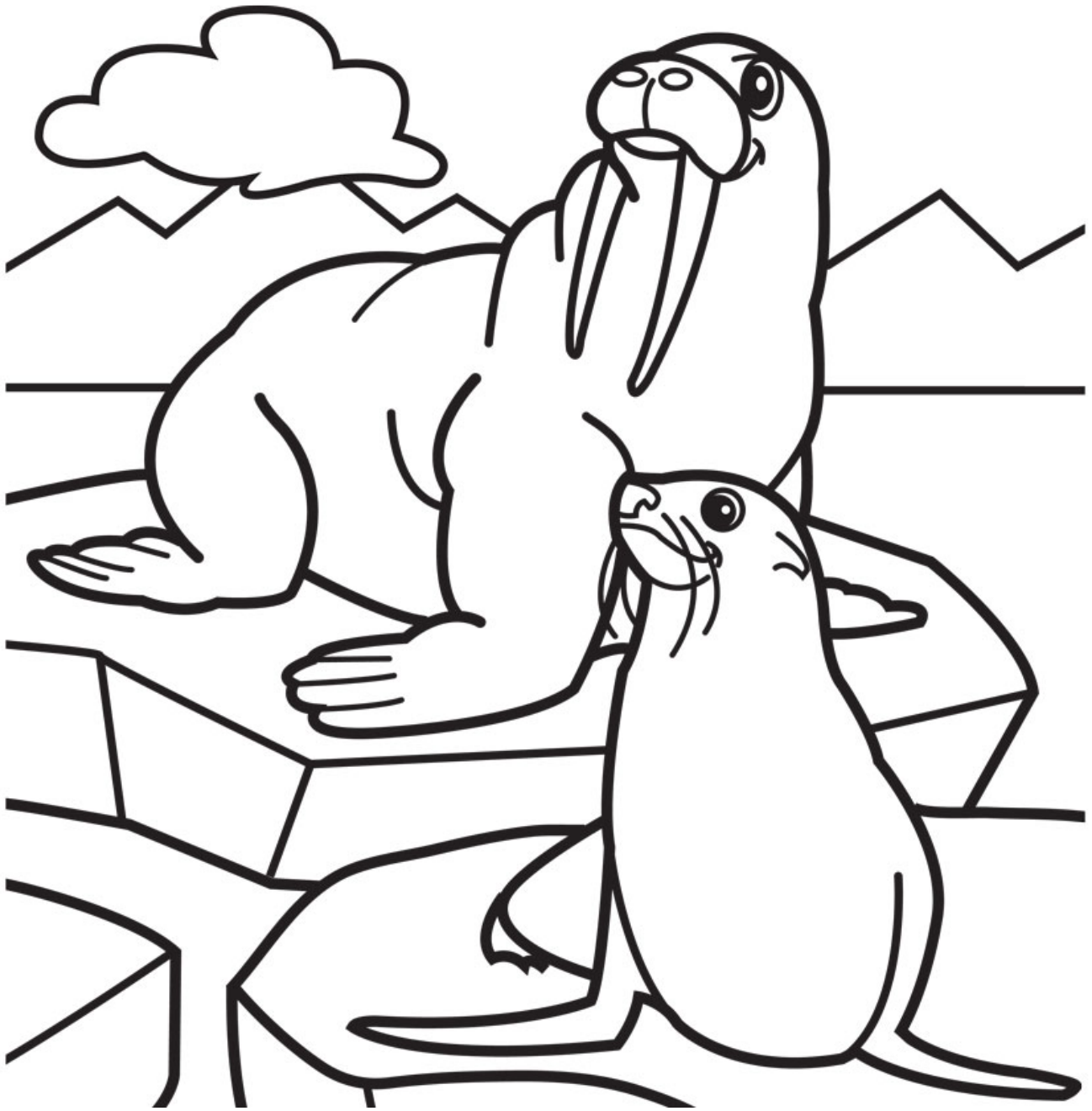
