

2 – 4 Year Olds Children’s Meeting

LESSON 7 -- THE SUN

TEACHERS: pray together and read Genesis 1:14-19

OPENING TIME: Sing “This is the day, this is the day, that the Lord has made”
“If you’re happy and you know it, clap your hands...call Oh Lord...say amen”

BIBLE VERSE: “God made...the two great light-bearers, the greater light bearer to rule the day...” Genesis 1:16

LESSON:

1. On the fourth day God made the sun, the moon and the stars.
2. The Bible tells us that the sun rules the day. What do you think that means?
3. The sun is the most important thing in the day. What are some things that make the sun important?
 - a. It makes the plants grow.
 - b. It makes the vegetables and fruits good to eat.
 - c. It makes the leaves turn green and the trees grow.
 - d. It makes people healthy.
 - e. It gives us light during the day so can see to walk, play, work, read....
4. The sun also causes shadows. A shadow happens when something is blocking the light of the sun or another source of light like a lamp. Our shadow is our shape when we block the sun’s light from hitting the ground. It will move when we move and however we move. The shadow of a tree is in the shape of that tree. What shape is a dog’s shadow? A car? A hand? In the morning and evening our shadows are tall, but in the middle of the day, our shadows are very small because the sun is right above us.

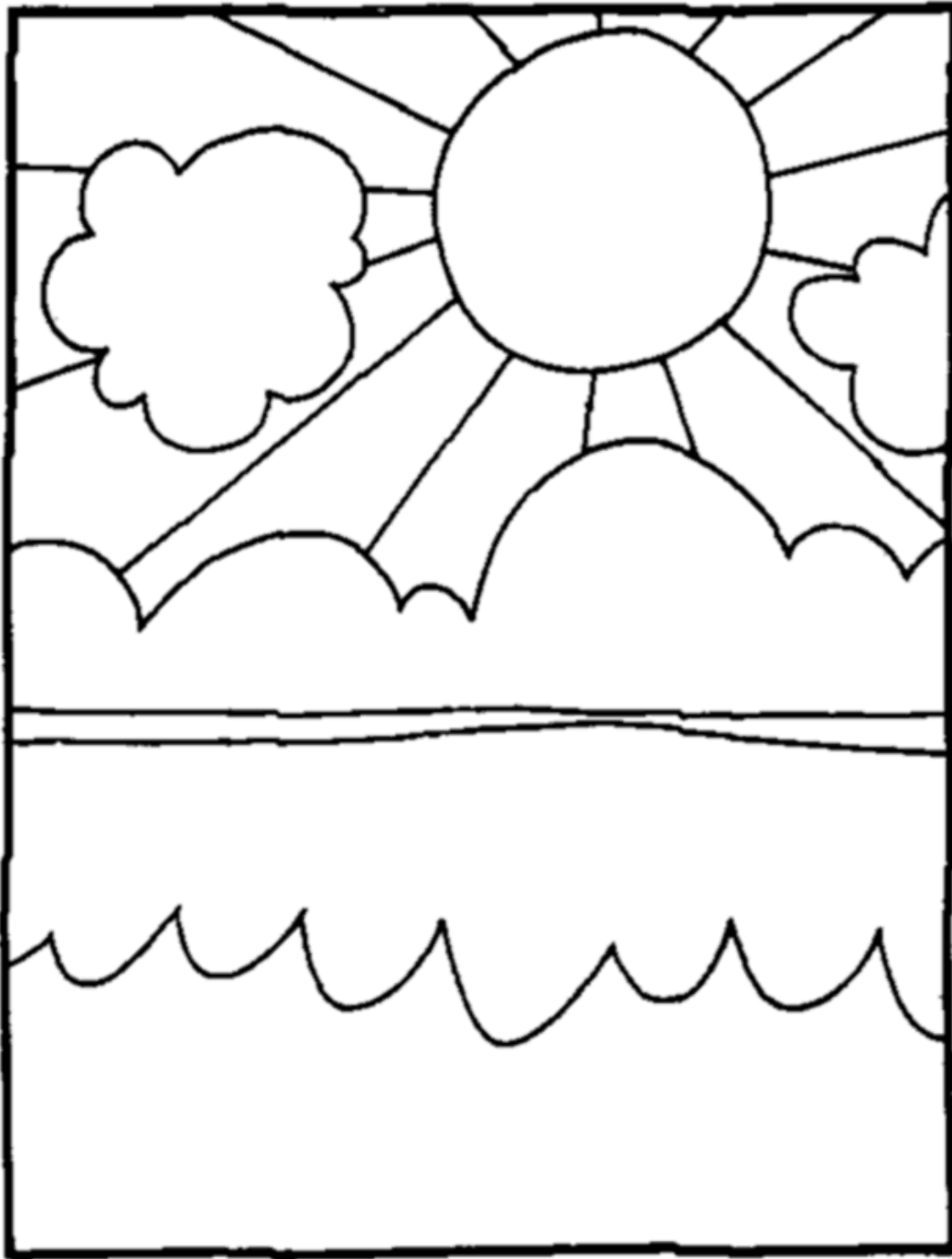
