

2 – 4 Year Olds Children’s Meeting

LESSON 11 FALL HARVEST

TEACHERS: Pray together and read; Genesis 8:22, Ecclesiastes 3:1-12

OPENING TIME: Sing “Thank Him, Thank Him all ye little children”
“God made the Mountains”
“His Word is sweet to my taste”

BIBLE VERSE: “ To everything there is a season - a time to plant and a time to pluck up what is planted.”—Ecclesiastes 3:1a, 2b

LESSON:

1. During harvest time all the bounty of the summer fruits (such as apples and pumpkins,) vegetables, grains are brought in by the farmer to his storehouse, barn, so there will be a bountiful supply of food for his family during the cold winter months.
2. Each crop is harvested in it’s own special way. Apples are picked from trees (not shaken off the trees,) pumpkins and squash are picked from the vine, potatoes are dug from the ground, wheat and corn are harvested by special equipment that is pulled by the farmer’s tractor.
3. Tell simple story of how Joseph stored supplies for all the people when there was a good growing season to prepare for a time when food did not grow well. When there was a lack of food he was able to feed all the people from the bountiful storage.
4. We are thankful for the harvest. During this time of the year, we have a special time to thank God for His care for us.
