LESSON 51 EARTHWORMS

TEACHERS: Pray together and read Genesis 1:10 – 13

OPENING TIME: SONGS -- Why was a Cup Made

BIBLE VERSE: Gen 1:26 “... over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.”

LESSON:

1. God made earthworms.
2. Earthworms live in the soil.
3. Worms have no arms, legs, or eyes.
4. Their skin is sticky and slimy which help them from drying out.
5. When the worms dry out, they will die, because they breathe through their skin.
6. Earthworms are very helpful to farmers and gardeners.
7. Their tunneling in the soil loosens the soil so water and nutrients can go down and enrich the soil. They also help plants by mixing the soil.
8. Earthworms have the ability to replace or replicate lost segments. This ability varies greatly depending on the species of worm you have, the amount of damage to the worm and where it is cut. It may be easy for a worm to replace a lost tail, but may be very difficult or impossible to replace a lost head if things are not just right.
