

## Children's Meeting – PreK & K – Lesson 1

Title – The Bible

Main Burden – Bible is the Word of God

Introduction to a new class --

1. Tell the children our (the teachers') names, and say their names while we put their name tags on them.
2. Sing a welcome song with the each of the children's names  
(to the tune of B-I-B-L-E)  
Yeah Kayla's here today,  
Kayla's here today,  
We sing and pray, and  
Learn the Word of God,  
Yes, Kayla's here today.

Show the children their notebooks --

1. Show them the teacher's notebook with Lesson 1 with the corresponding coloring page and memory verse page; explain to the children how we will add their papers to their notebooks at the end of each lesson.
2. Emphasize how important it is for them to bring their notebooks back each time, and that they will receive a sticker if they say the memory verse.

Lesson 1      The Bible

1. Today our lesson is on 'The Bible'. Show the children your Bible.
2. You might have read lots of other books like 'Curious George' or 'The Lady Who Swallowed a Fly', but do you know that the Bible is the most wonderful book?
3. The Bible is the most important book in the world; it is the most wonderful book. Why? (let the children answer ...and then point out a few of the following points)
  1. The Bible is unique – that means that there is no other book like the Bible.
  2. The Bible is God's speaking – no other book is God's speaking.
  3. God spoke and moved men to write down His words.
  4. The Bible is the Word of God.
  5. The Bible tells us everything about God, like who God is and what He has done.
  6. The Bible also tells us that God loves us so much that He gave us His only Son.
  7. The Bible has been translated into many languages, like Spanish, Chinese, German ... for people who live in different parts of the world and speak different languages.
  8. The Bible is composed of 66 books, and each book has many chapters, and in each chapter, there are many verses. (Some of you will be learning to read, and will soon be reading chapter books.)
  9. We also refer to these verses as the Scripture.
  10. A Scripture is sacred, is holy.
  11. God's Word is holy.
  12. God's Word is the very breath of God.

13. Breath – we inhale and exhale, breath in and breath out, we are breathing when we are alive!

14. God is alive; He is living; His Word is the very breath of God.

4. Give each child his lesson sheet.

Read the lines on the lesson with the children, and have them repeat after you.

You may want to repeat each line twice.

5. Memory Verse: (Say it to the children and then have them repeat with you several times.)

“All Scripture is God-breathed...” 2 Tim 3:16

6. Song – Sing several times.

(Hymnal.net – Children Songs – ‘I love the Bible, the Word of God’)

7. Today we are going to color and trace the words “The Bible is the Word of God.”  
Show the children the coloring page and point to the words where they are to trace.

8. Now we are going to make a Mini Bible with our memory verse in it.  
Explain and do one step at a time, going around to make sure every one completes the step correctly.

9. While the children are making the Mini Book, one teacher can go around and put the Children’s Lesson and Coloring pages in their notebooks.

Preparation --

Make name tags for all the teachers and the children

Prepare the notebooks

Pray over 2 Tim 3:16.

Learn the song – Hymnal.net – Children Songs – ‘I love the Bible, the Word of God’

Make copies of the lesson and the coloring page for the children.

Make copies of the craft for the children.

You will need crayons, scissors, glue and a stapler.



## Craft for Lesson 1: The Mini Bible

### Instructions:

Get a piece of construction paper, fold it in half lengthwise and cut along the creased line. Each half will be used for one cover of the Mini Bible. Teachers may do this step before craft time, and give each child one piece later when they are ready for the cover.

Cut the following page along the dotted lines, make 4 pages.

Help the children to write their names on page 1 if they need help.

Make sure the pages are arranged in the right order.

Staple the pages together on the left side.

Give each child a piece of the half construction paper

Fold the construction paper in half to form the cover for the Mini Bible.

Glue page 4 to the inside of the right half of the construction paper.

Apply a little bit of glue over the staple.

Fold the construction paper over the glue to complete the cover of the Mini Bible.

Children may decorate the cover if they wish.

Read the memory verse together again using their Mini Bible.
