

Children's Meeting – PreK & K – Lesson 2

Title – The Only God

Main Burden -- There is only one God

I Introduction

1. Welcome the children, check any new ones or visitors, and learn their names.
2. Make sure the children know the teachers' names.

II Notebook & Memory Verse

1. Ask the children who can say their memory verse from last week.
2. Allow those who know the verse to say it one by one.
3. Put sticker on their lesson next to the memory verse.

III Review

1. Review Lesson 1: (ask the children questions, let them answer, and the teacher repeats the children's answers.)
2. What is the most wonderful book in the world?
Children: Bible
Teacher: Yes, you are right, the Bible is the most wonderful book in the world.
3. Why is the Bible the most wonderful book in the world?
Children: It is the Word of God.
Teacher: Wonderful! The Bible is the Word of God. Remember we talked about how God moved some people to write down what He spoke. Therefore the Bible is the Word of God; it is not the word from man.
4. Who remember what is a Scripture? This word is in your memory verse. Who can tell me what is a Scripture?
Children:
Teacher: Remember we talked about there are many books in the Bible, and each book has many chapters, and in each chapter, there are many verses. We refer to these verses as the Scripture. Your memory verse is in the book of 2 Timothy, chapter 3, verse 16.

IV Lesson 2

1. Now we are ready to look at what else is in the Bible.
2. What does the Bible tell us?
3. The Bible tells us that there is ONLY ONE GOD.
 - a) Many people worship other things as their god. Some people worship the sun; some people worship an image carved from wood.
 - b) The Bible tells us that there is only ONE GOD; besides this One there is no other God. We only worship this ONE GOD.
 - c) Isaiah 46:9 ... That I am God and there is no one else; I am God and there is no one like Me.
 - d) Our God is the one and only God.
4. The Bible is composed of two testaments, the Old Testament and the New Testament.
5. The Old Testament was written first.

6. In the Old Testament, the Bible tells us that GOD IS THE CREATOR.
 - a) He created everything, the sun, the moon, the animals, even the beautiful flowers.
 - b) God created all these things for us. We all like the beautiful flowers.
 - c) We will be spending more time learning about God's creation in the coming weeks.
7. God is invisible. We cannot see God, but the Bible tells us that GOD IS REAL.
 - a) Have you ever seen, tasted, or smelled God?
 - b) No?! But we know that God is real.
 - c) Do you know that your parents love you? Can you see, taste or smell love?
 - d) But from their smiles and their hugs, you know that your parents love you.
 - e) God is invisible, but we know that God is real.
 - f) In the Bible the book of Romans 1:20 tells us that ... through everything God made, man can clearly see God.
8. Summarizing today's lesson, now repeat after me –
 - a) There is only one God
 - b) God is the Creator
 - c) God is real

V Give each child his/her lesson sheet.

Read the lines on the lesson with the children, and have them repeat after you.
You may want to repeat each line at least twice.

VI Memory Verse: (Say it to the children and then have them repeat with you several times)
"That I am God and there is no one else." Isa 46:9

VII Song (These are suggested songs, you may sing other songs that the children like.)
The B-I-B-L-E
I love the Bible, the Word of God
Jesus loves me, this I know

VIII Coloring Page

Today we are going to color this page (show the children the coloring page) showing the picture of a Holy Bible. Remember God's Word is holy, and underneath the picture of the Bible, it says "THE BIBLE TELLS ME SO." What did we learned today?

There is only one God.
God is the Creator.
God is real.

If people were to ask you, "How do you know that?"
You will say, "The Bible tells me so."

IX Craft – Make a scroll.

X Preparation –

Read and pray over Isaiah 43:10, 44:6, 46:9.

Make copies of the lesson and the coloring page for the children.

Obtain pairs of chopsticks, one pair per child.

Obtain brown construction paper, pre-cut horizontally into half sheets. Each child will need a half sheet.

You will need strings, crayons, or markers, glue, and tape

God is real.



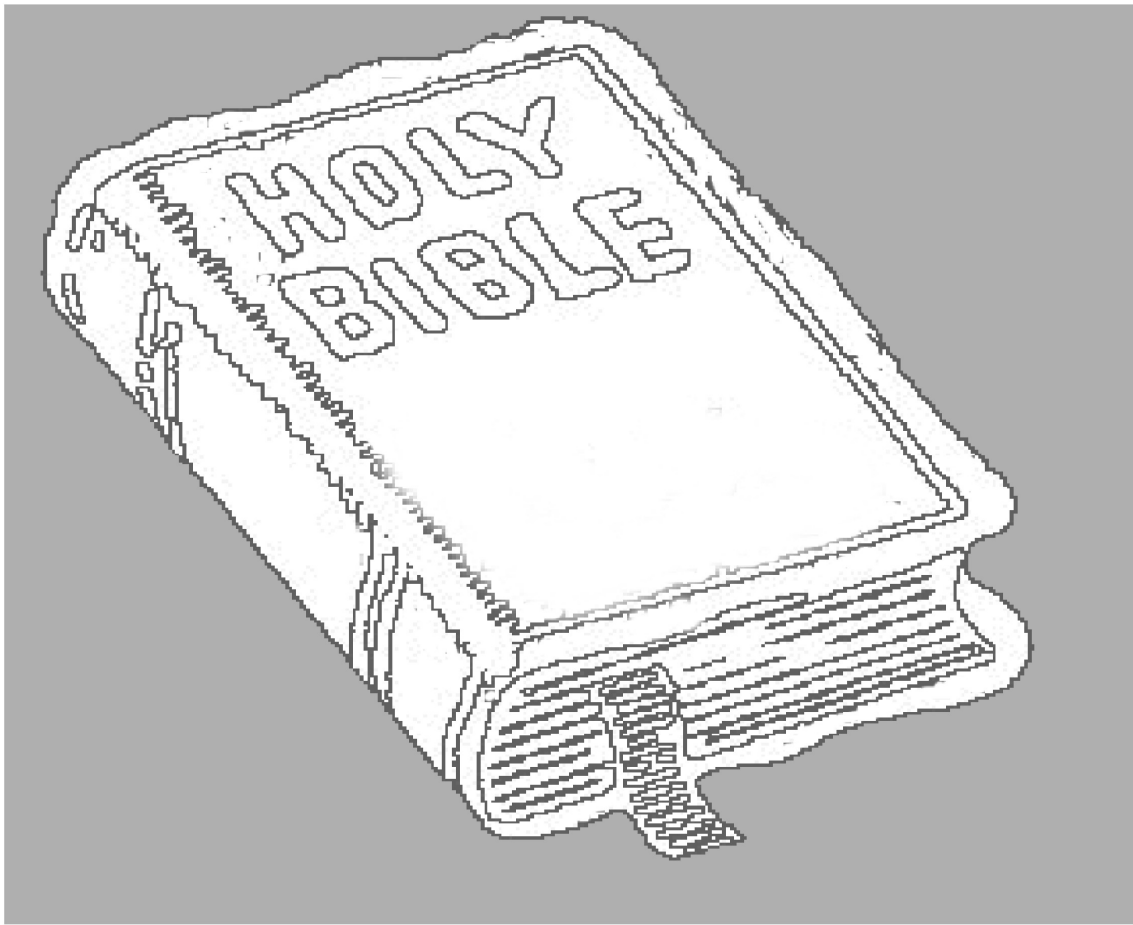
Bible Verse:

CRAFT

Make a scroll

Some books of the Old Testament of the Bible are called the "Torah". The books were written on thick scrolls of paper rolled up horizontally from the sides into the center. Today we are going to make a scroll that looks like a Torah.

Step 1 – Cut brown construction paper in half horizontally, making a narrow strip. Give each child one of these half sheets of brown construction paper.

Step 2 – Allow the children to scribble across the paper pretending to be the writings.

Step 3 – Give each child a pair of chopsticks, separate them.

Step 4 – Lay the chopsticks on the edges of the construction paper. Glue & tape them down securely. Make sure there is one rolled-up chopstick on each side.

Step 5 – Roll the scroll to the center from both sides.

Step 6 – Lightly tie a string around it.
