

## 2 – 4 Year Olds Children’s Meeting

### LESSON 4 -- God’s Creation – Third Day – God let the dry land appear

**TEACHERS:** pray together and read Genesis 1:9-13

**OPENING TIME:** sing “the heavens are for the earth” and other songs

**BIBLE VERSE:** “And God said, Let the waters...be gathered into one place, and let the dry land appear.” Gen. 1: 9

#### LESSON:

1. God loves man, so in His creation God prepared everything in the heavens and on the earth so man could have a very pleasant place to live.
2. On the third day, by His speaking, God gathered the waters together and the dry land appeared.
3. When the dry land appeared, some of the land was soft and dark. It is called soil. It is good for growing things. On the land were many rocks. God created different rocks of many sizes, shapes and colors. Some of the land was sand, especially around the oceans and lakes or in the desert. Sand, rocks and soil are three kinds of dry land we see.
4. Show the children a globe so they can see how the oceans no longer cover the whole earth. They have been gathered into certain places. Jeremiah 5:22 tells us that God placed the sand as a boundary for the sea, a boundary for the tossing, roaring waves.

#### ACTIVITIES:

Bring samples of soil, rocks and sand for the children to examine.

Or allow the children to collect different kinds of rocks or sand during outdoor play.
