

## God's Purpose Fulfilled

#### I. Overview.


#### II. Memory Verse.


"But Jehovah said to David my father... it was on your heart to build a house for My name...

God's purpose with the children of Israel was to gain His expression through them. God desires to be expressed in His person – so that all would know who He is. God also desires to be expressed in His authority – so that He could maintain the best order in the universe and all His enemies would be conquered. God carried out His purpose with Israel by their inheriting the Good Land and by building up the Temple of God and the city of Jerusalem.

#### David and Solomon - Builders for God's Expression

It was on David's heart to build a house for God, but it was Solomon his son who actually built the house. God was very satisfied with the Temple that Solomon built, for it gave Him an excellent expression among His people. David and Solomon were also kings who did much to build up the city of Jerusalem and the kingdom. As a result God's authority was raised up among His people and among the nations.

God's purpose was fulfilled with the children of Israel when He had gained His expression among them. God greatly blessed Israel and made them strong. They ruled all the nations around them and gave great glory to God.

#### God's Purpose in the New Testament
